



## Come jump into Spring with us!



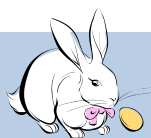

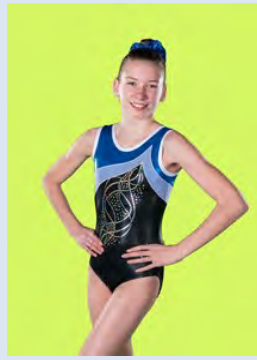
## Competitive

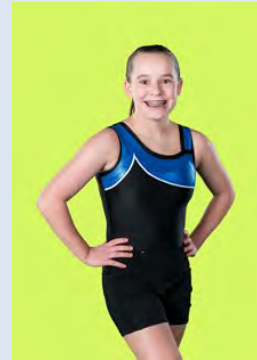
## Interclub

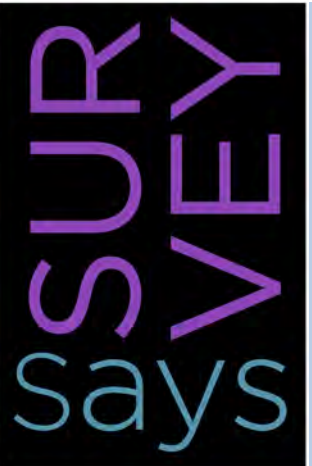

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# Gellert Phase 2 Survey / Facility Update



On behalf of the Board of Directors, I would like to express my appreciation to all of you who responded to the survey this past January. The survey asked if you supported HHGC being a part of the proposed Gellert Phase 2 Recreational complex. We received well over 500 responses.

Since that survey took place, we have been in contact with the Town of Halton Hills and discussions will continue in the weeks and months ahead.

In accordance with our 5 year strategic plan, the Board has a mandate to make sure HHGC can meet the needs of our growing community. The bottom line is that HHGC will need a new, modern facility in the next few years. However, we are not limiting ourselves to just the Gellert Phase 2 Recreational Complex. We are in the process of exploring all potential scenarios and options.
